The Registrar of Mortgage Brokers (Registrar) requires persons who are registered as mortgage brokers or submortgage brokers under the *Mortgage Brokers Act* (Act) to qualify for each and every registration renewal, and unregistered persons to qualify for reinstatement of their registration, by taking continuing education as follows:

1. The “Regulatory Update for Mortgage Brokers” webinar at the time of registration renewal or registration reinstatement (available from the Mortgage Brokers Institute of British Columbia (MBIBC)); and
2. Two (2) online modules approved by the Registrar.

The Registrar has approved the following online modules as meeting BC continuing education requirements:
